Also, if you have suggestions on how the project could be improved, please provide that information as well. Your feedback will help strengthen your colleagues' projects. Try to be concise.

Based on your reports I will come up with a global ranking of all proposals and provide you with an averaged score for your proposal. Note that this will not be the actual grade for the proposal part of your project. I will come up with the grade, based on the requirements specified in the project description.
